

Review of A physical concept in the press: the case of the Jet Stream

I found this an interesting article very much in line with sentiments that I have come across – that although many people use the terms GHG, Jet Stream and climate change they do not understand either the terminology itself or the importance of the links between them. The hypothesis that the use of news articles to disseminate science ideas is therefore very appealing.

The article follows the traditional academic pattern of research although the survey is small it does seem to purvey the general lack of understanding of science terms even by an educated populace. Awareness raising of this nature is very necessary and should be increased.

Line 230 'an' experience

Line 236 it allows (opportunities?)

Line 276 I ?

Line 470....so that the public can piece together each part of the complex puzzle that forms the Earth's climate....
